Final Project Presentation

Final project presentations will take place during the regular class time on Monday, February 5. On the day of the presentation, please be sure to arrive early to set up your demo at your usual machine. You will have 10 minutes to demo and talk about your work, followed by 5 minutes of questions. Your presentation should start with an introduction to the members of your group and a brief description of the basic idea behind your project. Don't forget that the main purpose of the presentation is to show off your project, so try not to talk too much! Don't hesitate to use visuals to help explain how your project works, but try to avoid a PowerPoint slide presentation.

The presentation is 15% of your project grade. Prizes will also be offered to the best project(s).

Final Project Website

You should also prepare a small write-up on the work you did in the form of a simple website. It should include the following information:

- Name of your project.
- Names of all group members.
- Your original project proposal.
- Brief introduction describing what your project, and the motivation behind your idea.
- A high-level list of tasks your accomplished for your project.
- Brief description of any specific problems/challenges you encountered.
- Possibilities for future work.
- List of references.
- Links to your source code, Quartz Composer patches, Max/MSP patches, etc...

You will not be graded on how your website looks, so just keep it simple and clean.

Email an archive of your website to eric@cs.rwth-aachen.de by Wednesday, February 7 at 23:59.

The archive should be **stand-alone** and **complete**, including the source code and patches. You may link to external websites in your references section, everything else should be included in your archive.

The entry point of your website should be a file named exactly "**index.html**".

The website is 15% of your project grade.

Self-Evaluations

Individually, you should also send in a brief self-evaluation for the project by email in **plain-text**. Please include the following information in your self-evaluation:

- Your name.
- Names of all group members.
- Your % contribution to the project.
- % contribution of your other group members to the project.
- A short list of what/how you contributed to the project.

The self-evaluation should be completed **individually**. All information you submit will be kept strictly confidential and will not be revealed to anyone.

The self-evaluation is 5% of your project grade.

Submission

Submit an archive of your website (one per group) to eric@cs.rwth-aachen.de by **Wednesday, February 7, 2007 at 23:59**. The subject of your email should be "**M3 Project**". Individually, you should also send the completed self-evaluation form by email with the subject "**M3 Evaluation**". Be sure to use these **exact** subject lines as it will be used to filter assignment submissions for grading.
